

## The Nature Conservancy Code of Conduct

Pawling Nature Reserve Deer Management Program

- 1) Hunter's outer garments must be at least 50% orange or red. A red or orange hat is mandatory
- 2) There will be no shooting across open fields, marshes or roads
- 3) Unnecessary shooting or shooting at targets is not allowed
- 4) Be sure of your game. No other species or birds or animals may be taken or possessed on the Reserve
- 5) Alcoholic beverages are strictly prohibited on the Reserve
- 6) Smoking is not allowed
- 7) All New York State and Federal laws will apply and must be observed
- 8) Any violation of the above **Code Of Conduct** or any illegal or unsafe hunting practices will result in the hunter's removal from the Reserve and result in the forfeiture of the hunters chance of participating in any future deer management programs at PNR.
